



Anaesthetic Emergency Protocol - Bradycardia

Essential monitoring

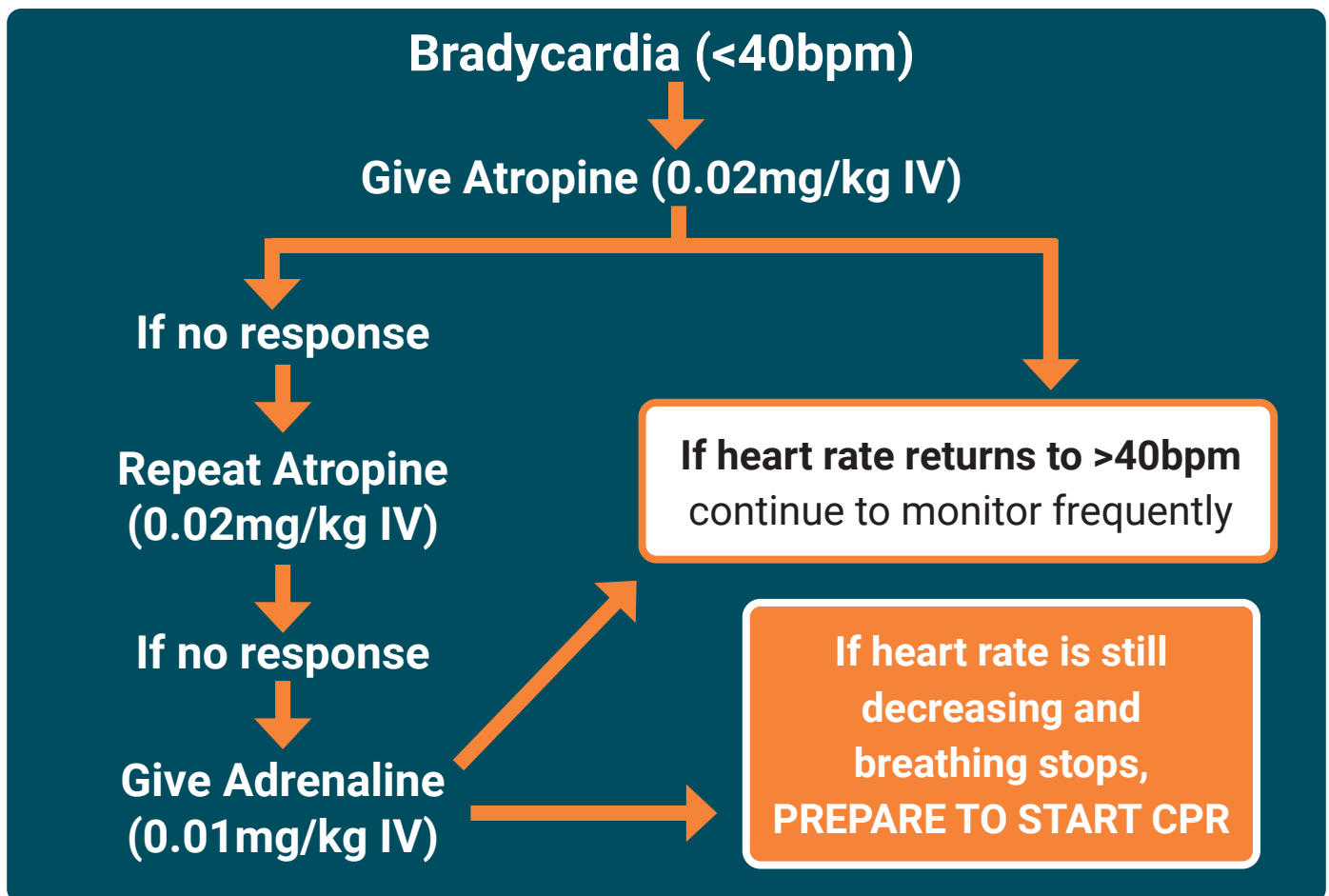
- Heart rate
- Breathing rate
- Peripheral pulse
- Gum colour
- Capillary refill time

Atropine

- Anticholinergic
- Increases heart rate
- Treats bradycardia (low HR) caused by high vagal tone such as an anaesthetic overdose

Adrenaline

- Catecholamine
- Increases heart rate
- Increases peripheral vasoconstriction
- Increases arterial blood pressure
