


Jaw tone	Present	Present	Possible/Absent
Movement	Possible	Present	Possible/Absent
Heart rate	Usually increased		Usually decreased
Respiratory rate	Usually increased		Usually decreased
Haemodynamic &/or respiratory variations following surgical stimulation	Yes	Usually no	No
